We were able to access a grant to begin the project and have had the cement platform constructed. Some of you have already enjoyed the music performances that we have been able to provide due to this construction and hope you will join us on August 28th for one more performance. We plan to use this site for future educational and art performance events also.

We have begun building the pavilion. As many of you know, we are largely funding this build through our ioby crowdfunding, which is posted on the Ben Franklin Community Garden website. Many of you may also know that the cost of building material has doubled or tripled since the beginning of this year. We are significantly short of our funding goal and are reaching out to you in hopes that you will be able to make a donation to this project which will benefit the garden immediately and for years to come.
