Our Kick-off Meeting was held via Zoom on Tuesday, May 10th. If you were unable to attend, please take the time to watch the recording of the meeting. Link to YouTube video is below. It contains important information regarding the 2022 season.

Some items of note:

• Opening weekend is tentatively scheduled for May 21-22 (weather permitting). Greg has been out on the tractor working hard to get the garden ready. Garden

opening will be announced on social media, through Remind message and on our website. Please wait until announcement is made to bring your things into the garden.

- During the first 2 weeks of the season, the 3 parking spaces inside the garden gate are to be used for unloading only. Once unloaded, please move your car to the parking lot to allow for fellow gardeners to unload their cars. Handicap spots are only to be used by those with a handicap placard.
- When plants arrive at the garden, please review the white board regarding the number of plants allotted per plot. Seeds are also available. Please take only what you will use in your plot.
- Bulletin board on garden shed will contain information about events and garden happenings. Please review it periodically. If you have a gardening question, please post it on the board and another gardener may have some advice to offer.
- Sweet Potatoes: If purchasing sweet potatoes at the garden, cost is \$9. Please put exact change in an envelope and deposit it in the mailbox on the shed door. No money is to be given to Greg. Each bundle has 25 slips.
