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Volunteer Hours

Our garden is only able to operate and thrive thanks to the hard work and dedication of our garden volunteers.

And, in fact, when we signed up for our seasonal plots, we signed on to the Garden Rules which assert: "In keeping with the intention and meaning of a community garden, and in an effort to defray costs and maximize grant awards, each Gardener and Co-Gardener is required to donate a minimum of five (5) hours per plot toward the operation, maintenance, and promotion of the Garden."

This translates to:

- one full or half plot or raised bed: 5 hours
- one full or half plot & raised bed: 10 hours
- one full & half (1.5) plots: 10 hours
- two full plots: 10 hours
- one full & half (1.5) plots & raised bed: 15 hours
- two full plots & raised bed: 15 hours
- two full & half (2.5) plots: 15 hours
- two full & half (2.5) plots & raised bed: 20 hours
- three full plots: 15
- three full plots & raised bed: 20 hours

All hours and/or monetary donation must be completed by the end of the day 10/15/23 in order to be in good standing and receive a 2024 application

Garden Close-Out

Remember, that in order to receive your application for the 2024 season you must be in good standing with a proper close-out of your plot(s).

In order to sign out:

- Remove all inorganic, man-made materials (e.g., cages, stakes, fabric, plant markers);
- · Level any hills or troughs;

- Cut vegetation to two (2) feet in height/length (especially important for squash and sweet potato vines to spare tangling in the tractor).
- But, please, leave all your flowers in place for our bees and other pollinators!
- Note also that you are encouraged to leave your organic vegetation to biodegrade in your garden. Only remove diseased materials.

When your plot is ready, simply meet with a committee member or the garden coordinator to sign out. The committee member/Garden Coordinator will look over your plot to ensure that you have done all of the above. If volunteer time is owed, you may give the check-out person funds to cover your remaining hours. You and the check-out person will then sign the check-out form. If hours are due, you are not officially signed out until hours are completed or a monetary donation is made.
